要旨

In the Federal Dispatch on the Promotion of Education, Research and Innovation for 2008-2011, the Swiss Confederation set a new emphasis in its foreign science policy, naming eight non-EU countries with which it wished to broaden and deepen bilateral scientific relations. Japan is among the priority countries. A bilateral agreement on science and technology cooperation between the Federal Council and the Japanese government was signed on July 10, 2007 by former Vice-President Pascal Couchepin and former Foreign Minister Taro Aso. As stipulated in the Agreement, regular Joint Committee meetings, to exchange information and to review cooperative activities, is being alternately held in a two to three year interval. The first meeting took place in February 2009 in Bern. The two sides exchanged views on recent science, technology and innovation policies, activities and achievements, and agreed that the Countries should further promote Bilateral collaboration.

Dr. Felix Moesner, Head, Science & Technology Office Tokyo, Embassy of Switzerland will explain about the collaboration activities between Switzerland and Japan in the fields of R&D and education.
