Expected participants: Approximately 40 PhD students from GMSI-UT, 20 PhD students from SNU (mostly from BK21MAE), and 20 from outside Japan and Korea are expected to attend the Camp. Professors, researchers, and staff of GMSI and BK21MAE will also attend.

The camp will be conducted entirely in English.

Expenses: GMSI will cover the cost of airfare and accommodation, as well as provide a daily allowance for

the duration of the camp (from July 27 to July 30). This support is subject to the same conditions as regular travel support for attending international conferences and/or visiting affiliated institutions. The camp schedule, including the flight to/from Seoul is fixed; modifications to this schedule cannot be made.

Qualifications for participation: To be eligible for admission to this program, you must

- be a PhD student engaged in GMSI be able to actively participate in discussions in English
- have a will to attend all the activities during the camp (technical presentations, group discussions, lectures and informal exchange among participants)
- 3) have not participated in any previous GMSI Summer Camps.

Miscellaneous: For accommodation, 2-3 students will share one Western-style room.
