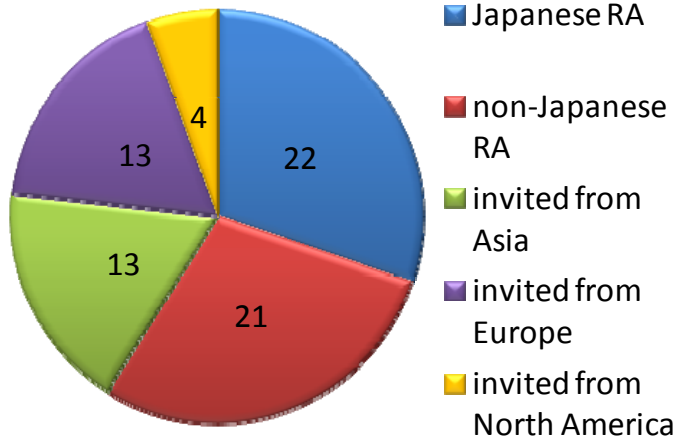

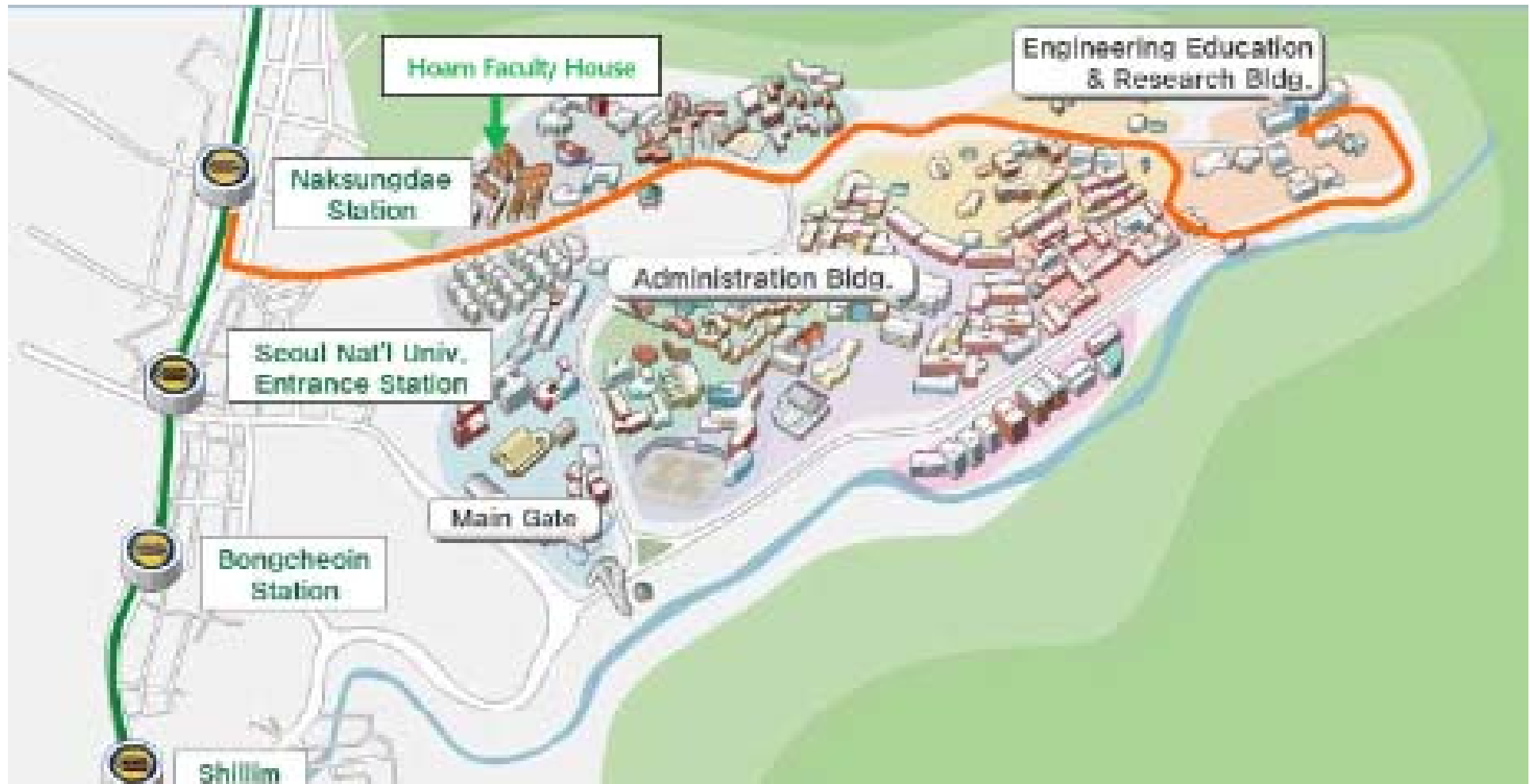

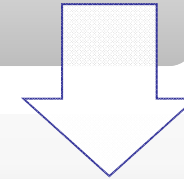
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- The situation:

  - Your task is to present what your department will develop, and why

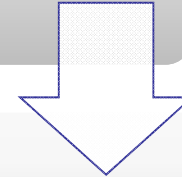
# A few conditions

  - Add pages and change the order as you see fit.

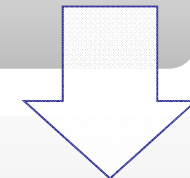
