

2011 GMSI-BK21MAE Summer Camp

General Information

This year's Summer Camp will bring together 78 PhD students in a variety of engineering fields from 15 universities in a dozen different countries. Participants will be divided into small teams, and the task of each team will be to present a novel idea for a product or service related to one of the following five topics:

- Energy (Teams 1&2)
- Environment (Teams 3&4)
- Safety & Security (Teams 5&6)
- Information Technology (Teams 7&8)
- Health & Welfare (Teams 9&10)

The organizers will attempt to maintain team diversity while assembling teams based on similar research fields. The teams will be announced shortly before the start of the camp.

To help everyone get to know their fellow teammates, there will be a 'Technical Session' in which everyone is requested to introduce themselves and their research topic in a short (5 minute) Powerpoint-style presentation. The purpose is to introduce yourself to your team and give everyone a general idea of your research topic, so there is no need to go into great detail (i.e., no conference-type talks.)

All meals and lodging during the camp will be provided for those participants traveling to Korea. Lunch and dinner will be provided for participants from Korea.

Take the Airport Limousine Bus (# 6017) at the bus stop 6B to SNU Hoam Faculty House. Get off in front of hotel (HFF)

- Interval: 40-50 min

- Traveling Time: 70min

- Fare: KRW 15,000 (~=USD 13)

- ICN » SNU Hoam Faculty House

Take a taxi at the airport directly to SNU Hoam Faculty House.

It will take about an hour. The fare will be about KRW 55,000 (~= USD 46) for standard taxi.

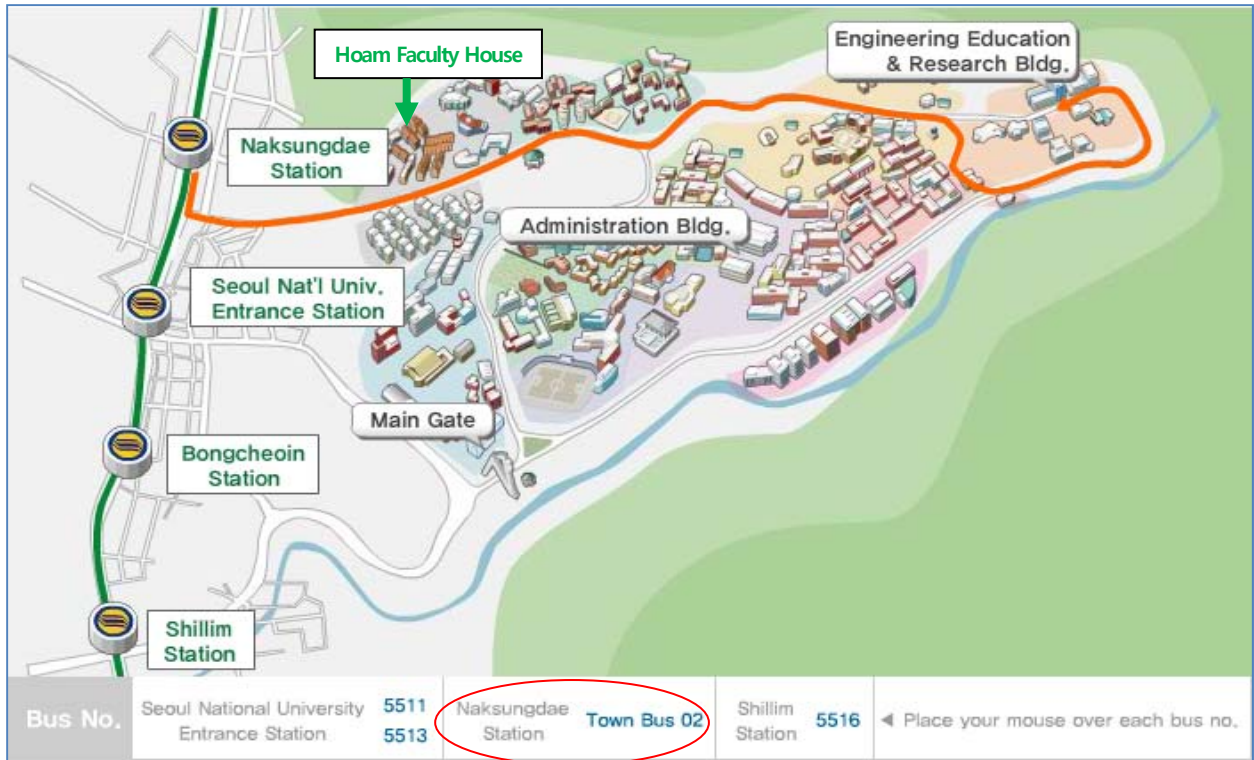

From Hoam Faculty House(or Subway) to GMSI Camp Venue (Building No. 301 Room 105)



1) Subway-> Building No. 301

Take **subway line no. 2 (Green Line)** and get off at **Naksungdae station**. After **exiting the exit no.4**, walk straight and make a left turn at the gas station and take on the **no. 관악 2 town bus** in front of Jean Blanc bakery. Get off the bus at the station "New engineering building"(Engineering Education & Research Bldg.301 or 302 (bus stop #9 or #10)). It takes about 20~25 minutes.

2) Hoam Faculty House (HFH)-> Building No. 301

The distance between the HFH and Bldg.301 is too long to walk and the following alternatives are recommended.

1) There is a free shuttle bus service for Hoam Faculty House users. If you want to use it, you should reserve at the HFH front desk.

2) You can also use regular bus No 관악 02, which runs from Nakseongdae subway station to the campus through the back gate. Crossing the street in front of the HFH, take this bus at the bus stop #22. Get off the bus at station "New engineering building"(Get off at either the bus stop No. 9 or 10 which are in front of buildings 302 or 301, respectively). It takes about 20 minutes. Preferably, it is recommended to get off at the bus stop #9(at building 302) and walk down to the building 301.
