

GMSI Program 2013 GMSI Summer Camp (Engineering Competency III : 3799-148) – Call for Participation –

The GMSI Program at The University of Tokyo will hold a Summer Camp in September. By gathering together PhD students from various countries studying mechanical engineering and related fields, the Camp aims to widen the research perspective of the participants and facilitate international communication by developing international networks among young researchers. We invite PhD students from universities/departments related to GMSI to join the camp.

Dates: Friday, September 27 to Monday, September 30, 2013

Place: The University of Tokyo Sportia YAMANAKA,

Lake Yamanaka, at the base of Mt. Fuji

Sessions: 1) Technical presentations* and discussion on participants' research topics
2) Discussion and survey in small teams with presentations by each group
*Further details will be notified to the participants prior to the camp.

Tentative agenda:

Expected participants: Approximately 20 PhD students from the University of Tokyo and 10 from outside Japan are expected to attend the Camp. Professors, researchers, and staff of GMSI will also attend.

The camp will be conducted entirely in English.

Expenses: GMSI will cover all the cost for meals (from 28 September to 30 September), accommodation (2 nights) and transportation. The participants will need to pay for drinks at receptions and informal parties, as well as personal expenses.

Qualifications for participation:

To be eligible for admission to this Camp, you must

- a) be a student engaged in GMSI be able to actively participate in discussions in English
- b) have a will to attend all the activities during the camp (technical presentations, group discussions, lectures and informal exchange among participants)
- c) have not participated in any previous GMSI Summer Camps.

Application for participation to the summer camp:

Submit the application forms together with your abstract file to the GMSI Program office via Email (sc2013@pcil.t.u-tokyo.ac.jp) by June 14 21, 2013.

Note that GMSI will select participants from the applicants satisfying the above qualifications whilst considering balance among research fields, participating countries, etc.
